WHAT TO DO IF WCPS ARE CLOSED.....

ALL CENTERS

If Washington County Public Schools are closed to children, then all Head Start classrooms will be closed to children.

During this time please pay close attention to our announcements on Class Dojo, our website and social media outlets.

WHAT TO DO IF WCPS ARE DELAYED.....

Extended & Full Day Classrooms – Elgin, Shriver & Noland + MLK EHS These classrooms will have a delayed opening if Washington County Public Schools have a 2 hour delay. Elgin will open at 8:00am. Noland/Shriver/MLK EHS will be on a 2 hour delay for any bus service and opening.

Part Day Classes MLK

If Washington County Public Schools delay for 2 hours, all morning part-day classes will be cancelled. Afternoon part-day classes will operate as scheduled with a separate decision made later in the morning.

Home Based Services

Children served in the home based program will not have visits on days when WCPS or HSWC are closed due to weather. In the case of a 2 hour delay, visits will begin at 9:00am. In the case of an early dismissal, visits will end by 2:00pm.

Early Closings

If HSWC closes early due to weather or other emergencies, parents will be contacted by phone, text or through Class Dojo. Early Closings will be posted on the HSWC website.

For school closing information, call your child's center and listen to the recorded message or check the Head Start website or Facebook page.
